

## Test of Mathematics for University Admission (TMUA)

### Explanation of Results

Results for the TMUA are reported as a single overall score, on a scale that runs from 1.0 (low) to 9.0 (high). Scores are reported to one decimal place.

The scale has been designed so that typical candidates will score around 4.5. Approximately 10% of candidates will achieve scores higher than 7.0. Low scores are capped at 1.0 and high scores are capped at 9.0.

The distribution of scores from both the October 2025 and January 2026 sittings is shown below.
